There was an amazing turn out of people who Barry had had an impact over the years not just from MAFC but the Stewart Dance School whom both Barry and Noeline were also associated with. After such an awesome tribute, Barry sadly passed away a few months later. The following year, 1998, the Barry Hummels Memorial Game was created. This became an annual event organised by Barend, players both past and present came together yearly and gave match entertainment to those in the grandstand.

In later years, the club approached me and asked about changing the day to the club memorial to remember all past members. I agreed to this as it would have been what Dad would have wanted.

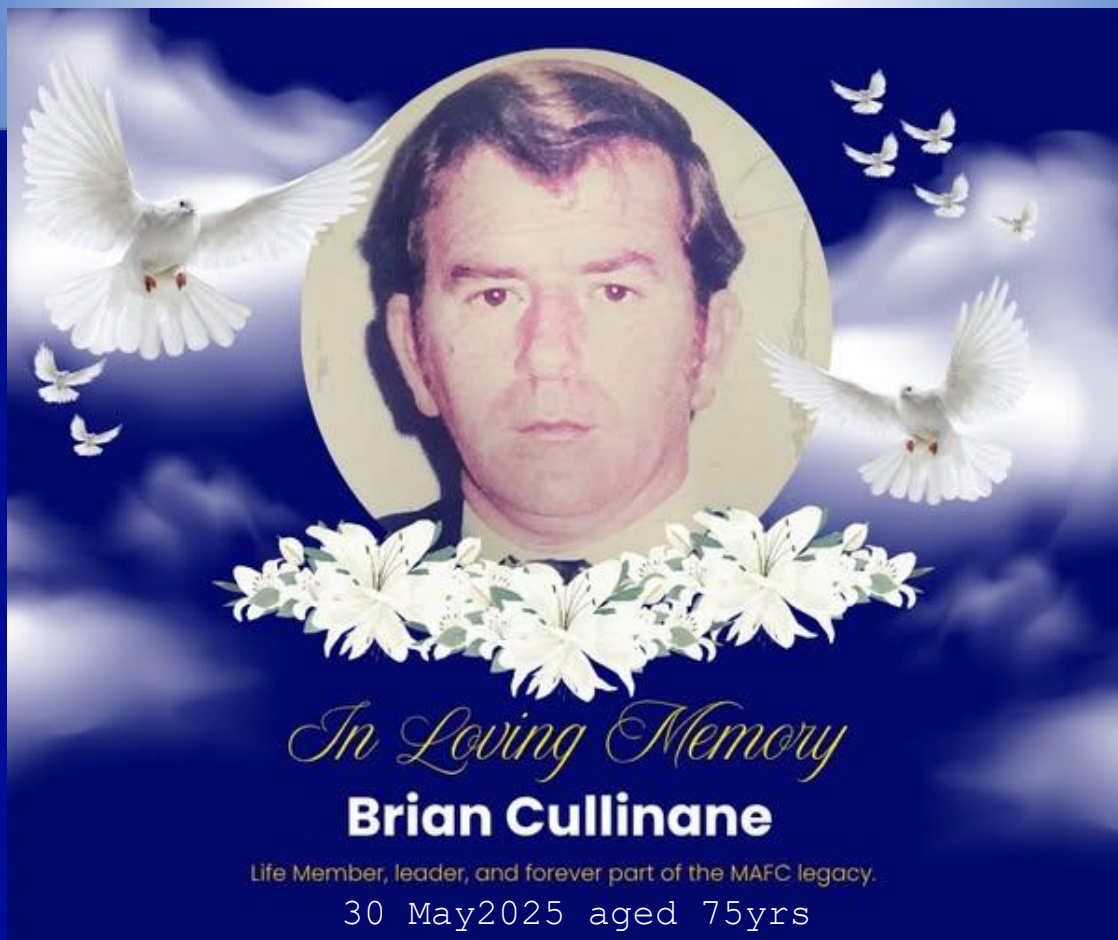
Barry joined MAFC in the early 1960s as a first team player. Over the following years he took on coaching many teams throughout the club and at rep level. He was also manager of the first team alongside John Adshead. Barry served on various committees and held positions on the control board. Whatever job Barry did around the club he gave it 110% especially fundraising ventures like cleaning of the Tegal Chicken factory in Takanini and many more.

Dad's legacy continued with two more generations of his family playing, coaching, managing and serving in various roles on committees with family still actively involved today.

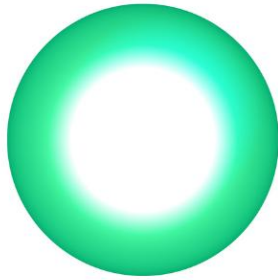
